Join Tom Pease, one of the best children’s music entertainers in the nation will be joining us tonight for a night of singing and dancing!

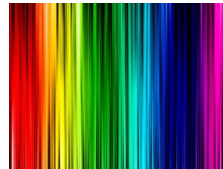


Wednesday, April 26
